

Did you know that we can supply coloured wristbands?

Failure to correctly identify patients is one of the most serious risks to patient safety. Coloured patient wristbands provide a convenient way to improve the accuracy of patient identification and treatment. Increasingly, NHS Hospitals are deploying coloured wristbands, which act as a visual alert, to assist healthcare professionals identify specific needs which patients may have.

Coloured wristbands can either be printed on, as unique patient identification, or worn blank alongside the white printed wristband.

Although there is no NHS Standard in place for wristband colours, our experience with Acute Trusts has found that most hospitals use the below:


ALLERGY
Hypersensitivity, intolerance or Adverse Drug Reaction (ADR)



INFECTION RISK
Patient at particular risk of infection, or patients who may pose a risk of infection to others




FISTULA IDENTIFICATION
The patient has had vascular surgery on that specific arm and no blood or blood pressure readings can be taken from that arm



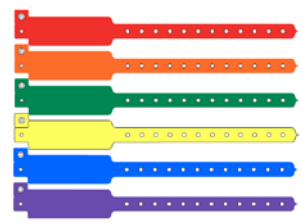
FALL RISK
Alert that the patient may be susceptible to falling due to age, injury or weakened by illness



COGNITIVE IMPAIRMENT
The patient needs to be considered when communicating as may have dementia or Alzheimer's
